We will finish our study of becoming play experts this week! Students will be making a new toy using their imagination and the materials sent in last week. They will reflect on what they learned about toys and playing with others. Students will interview someone in the other class to find out what classroom toy they prefer and how they like to play with that toy.

The core math group will be assessed on numbers 0-5 (counting objects in sets, drawing objects to show a number, and writing numbers). Then we will move on to numbers 6-10.

The enrichment math group will work on using counting to problem solve. They will figure out the difference between two numbers. They have been taught correct number formation for numbers 0-20. Mrs. Lockhart is still noticing some numbers written backwards. Please practice writing numbers at home.

As we wrap up quarter 1 , your child should be able to identify and know the correct sounds for the following letters: Aa, $\mathbf{T t}, \mathrm{Hh}, \mathrm{Pp}, \mathbf{C c}, \mathbf{N n}, \mathrm{Mm}$, and Rr. They should be able to read the following sight
