End of year assessments begin

This week we will focus on how trees are important to our community. We will be looking at reasons to support an author's point. Students will look at pictures of trees and use prepositions to describe positions. They will write about where a tree is located using prepositions in their sentences.

Students will be writing a personal narrative about what they did over Spring Break this week. We will also write an opinion piece about their favorite part of the farm field trip.

In math, we will continue to work on addition and subtraction. Students will begin at the concrete level and move to the abstract level. Manipulatives will be used and students will learn various strategies to show their work. They should be able to explain their thinking and tell how addition and subtraction are the same and how they are different. Students doing enrichment activities are learning about fact families.

Please practice counting to 100 at home if your child cannot already do so. The end of the year standard is for students to count to 100.

We are just **3 weeks** away from the start of end of year assessments. Please help us out by utilizing KidsA-Z (reading the books and taking the comprehension quizzes) and reading with your child every day! Reading the words is only part of being a good reader. You must also comprehend what you are reading.

How can you help support us at home?

Please be sure you are doing the fluency activities (in your child's purple folder) with your child at least 3 times per week. ** Work on sight words daily with your child! ** Utilize the technology resources in your child's daily folder. ** You should be reading with your child and letting your child read to you, daily.
