This week we will continue our study of how people can enjoy trees. We will read fiction stories and compare the actions of the characters.

In math, we will work on addition and subtraction. Students will begin at the concrete level and move to the abstract level. Manipulatives will be used and students will learn various strategies to show their work. They should be able to explain their thinking and tell how addition and subtraction are the same and how they are different.

Please practice counting to 100 at home if your child cannot already do so. The end of the year standard is for students to count to 100.
