This week we will continue our study of how trees are important to our community. We will focus on reasons to support an author's point. Students will compare two texts, looking for similarities and differences. Students will practice writing their own opinion statement with a reason telling why they feel that way.

In math, students will continue to work on word problems and various ways to solve the word problems. The benchmark group is using manipulatives, number paths and bar models. The enrichment group is using tens and ones, number lines and equations to solve problems.

Hopefully you have noticed that less homework is coming home. This is because we want your child to be on KidsA-Z as much as possible.
