<p>Activity 7 Use a page in the notebook to create a poster about fall. Be creative.</p>	<p>Activity 8 Draw and color: 4 red apples, 2 green apples, and 3 yellow apples. Circle the group that has the most.</p>	<p>Activity 9 Write the word FALL going down the page. Draw (or cut and glue) a picture that starts with each letter of the word. Put the picture beside the correct letter.</p>
<p>Activity 10 Draw and color: 3 orange pumpkins, 5 yellow pumpkins, and 1 brown pumpkin. Circle the group that has the least.</p>	<p>Activity 11 Draw and label a picture of a word the rhymes with at.</p>	<p>Activity 12 Draw a picture and color to solve. Mrs. Brann had 2 pumpkins. She bought 3 more pumpkins at the store. How many pumpkins does Mrs. Brann have now? Write and circle your answer.</p>
