This week's letter focus will continue to be Bb, Oo and Ww. Students will learn another mystery word this week. Handwriting will be taught one letter a day. Please continue to review all the mystery words and sight words taught so far.

In math, students will stay in homeroom classes to do holiday math activities.

How can you help support us at home?

Addition to your child's daily folder: We have added a Nonsense Word Fluency (NWF) practice page to the daily folder. Students will be assessed on this skill in January during mCLASS assessments. The intent of this measure is for students to be able to read unfamiliar words. The mid-year goal for correct letter sounds is 17.

You can also practice Phoneme Segmentation Fluency (PSF), another measure that will be assessed during mCLASS assessments in January. PSF measures the students' ability to segment the sounds in a word. It has been found to be a good indicator of later reading achievement. The mid-year goal for PSF is 20.

*Both Nonsense Word Fluency and Phoneme Segmentation Fluency are measures that have not yet been assessed.
